YOUNG COMPOSERS COMPETITION 2013

The Etobicoke Philharmonic Orchestra,
located in the City of Toronto, Ontario, invites submissions
for its first Young Composers Competition.

There will be three Prizes:

Grand Prize: \$2,000, plus a performance of the
winning composition at one of EPO's February, April
or May concerts in the 2013/2014 season.

Runner-Up: \$1,000

Promising High-School Composer: \$500

Deadline: Submissions must be received by November 1, 2013.

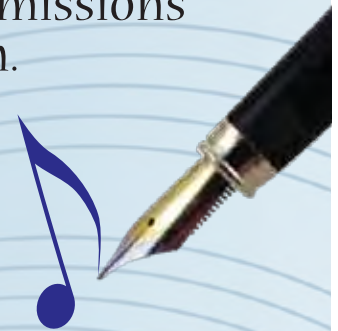
Eligibility:

1. Composers must be 32 years or under on the competition deadline, Nov. 1, 2013.
2. The competition is open to Canadian citizens. Proof of citizenship will be required for winning entries.
3. Works must be original compositions and ten minutes or less in duration.
4. Works must be scored for orchestra with 2222/4231, timp, perc, strings. Picc, 3rd flute and 3rd trumpet are available.
5. Promising High-School Composer entries may be considered for the Grand Prize and Runner-Up, at the judges' discretion.
6. Following the November 1 deadline judges may request a set of orchestra parts for short-listed compositions for an orchestra read-through.

Assessment: Entries will be assessed by a panel of three judges.

How to Apply: Submit a completed application form (available at www.eporchestra.ca) with two copies of the score. Include a brief biography. Submissions that include recordings (either orchestral or MIDI synthesized) are generally easier to assess.

Include only the name of the composition on the score. Do not include the composer's name. Entries with self-addressed envelopes with sufficient postage will be returned.
